Led by artistic director Valentín Rios Mata — alongside co-founders Alexandro Sandoval and Fabián Lechuga — the group merges traditional regional dance with contemporary ballet techniques used across México today.

From energetic rehearsals to educational workshops, Xochipilli has become a cultural pillar in Oklahoma City. The group welcomes dancers of all ages and backgrounds, creating a space where tradition thrives, community grows, and identity is honored.

He has worked with notable companies such as the Guadalupe Dance Company during the Lila Downs concert, Grupo Folclórico Norahua, and currently directs Ballet Folklórico Xochipilli. Valentín's roots in dance stretch back to age five, where he began performing in local festivals in Juan Aldama, Zacatecas, México. While pursuing a degree in accounting and business administration, he trained and performed for eight years under César Lara Bañuelos in the state folkloric dance company 'Zacatecas', mastering a range of styles including contemporary, jazz, flamenco, and ballet.
